

CANGIFT'S SAFETY FIRST REOPENING PLAN: What exhibitors can expect at the Toronto Gift + Home Market

In preparation for our community to once again come together, the Canadian Gift Association (CanGift) is dedicated to providing a safe and secure environment. Together with our facility partner, the Toronto Congress Centre and their C.H.A.S.E.™ program, as well as our suppliers, we are taking aggressive steps to protect everyone who attends our markets.

This document will detail the measures we have put in place to safeguard the health of all stakeholders – exhibitors, retailers, suppliers and staff to combat the spread and prevention of COVID-19. These practices may be updated as government and public health regulations change.

The following protocols will be in place:

MOVE IN

If you have had recent exposure to COVID-19, experience any COVID-19 symptoms or are feeling unwell, please do not attend.



Please pack your mask. Masks must be worn at all times and will be required of anyone who enters the building.



NEW!! Print and bring your badge. Exhibitors will be sent a link to download badges for staff. Click the link and print each badge onto a white 8 1/2" x 11" sheet of paper. Follow the folding instructions. You can forward the link to your staff person to have them print their badge OR you can print the badge and distribute it to your team in advance of arriving on show site. Badge holders will be available on site.



Please arrive at your scheduled move in time and proceed to the exhibitor check in desk at Door 4 (South Building) or Door 38 (North Building)



Produce your proof of full vaccination. To gain entry, you must be fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days) and show the digital or paper proof of **enhanced vaccine certificate with QR code**. Individuals can download their enhanced certificate with QR code by visiting <https://covid-19.ontario.ca/book-vaccine/>. The only exception is a medical exemption, in the form of an enhanced certificate with a QR code, accompanied by a negative test.



If your wristband needs to be replaced, you must provide proof of vaccination again to secure a new band.



Bring your own water. Water bottles are available for purchase; however, water stations and water fountains will not be available.

DURING THE SHOW

If you have had recent exposure to COVID-19, experience any COVID-19 symptoms or are feeling unwell, please do not attend.



Please wear your mask. Masks must be worn at all times and will be required of anyone who enters the building.



Bring your own water. Water bottles are available for purchase; however, water stations and water fountains will not be available.



If you are staying at one of the official hotels, shuttle buses will take you directly to the show.



If you are driving, please park in the designated exhibitor parking and use the exhibitor entrance.



Use the **hand sanitizer stations** conveniently placed at entrances and throughout the show floor.



Please stay within your booth. Minimize walking the show floor unless absolutely necessary.



Please observe physical distancing, of a minimum of 6ft at all times.



Housekeeping practices will exceed disinfecting standards. Electrostatic handheld disinfecting units will sanitize public spaces in the building before the market opens each day. All high contact surfaces will be disinfected continuously throughout the day.



First aid is available on site.



No cash please. All payment transactions will be cash free and tap ready.



Food offerings will be pre-packaged and presented with the highest of safety standards while continuing to maintain best in industry quality. Servers will be wearing masks and gloves.

16+

No one **under the age of 16** is permitted on the show floor.



Complimentary WiFi will be available throughout the buildings.
